

# Science Olympiad Scholarships

Please alert your senior Science Olympians to this opportunity.

The Goshen College Regional is offering eligible seniors competing in our tournament a one year Science Olympiad Scholarship for \$500. This scholarship must be used during the 2008–2009 academic year at Goshen College.

Eligible seniors are those who compete in the Goshen Regional and have applied or intend to apply immediately to Goshen College for admission.

Application forms will be available at registration and must be completed in advance of the competition.

The winner will be a senior with the most medal points. Gold = 4, Silver = 3, Bronze = 2, 4th = 1

If a winning senior cannot use the scholarship, it will be offered to next highest qualifier until a recipient is found.

## Scholarships Rules

This year the Goshen College Regional is offering a Science Olympiad Scholarship to eligible students competing in our region. This scholarship is available to high school seniors who are interested in attending Goshen College during the 2008–2009 academic year.

### Rules:

1. Seniors shall apply for the scholarship on the day of the Goshen College Regional Tournament. Scholarship registration forms will be available at the registration line on tournament day.
2. Applicants must have applied, or intend to apply by February 20, to Goshen College for admission next year.
3. Applicants shall take their application forms to each event in which they participate for the event judge to sign.
4. Before the closing ceremonies, each applicant's coach shall verify that all information on the application (including event and personal data) is correct and that the applicant is a senior and intends to graduate by August, 2008.
5. Applications will be turned in to the Scholarship Coordinator before the beginning of the award ceremonies.
6. Applicants shall notify the Scholarship Coordinator upon the receipt of each medal awarded. At the conclusion of the individual medal presentations, the scholarship coordinator shall determine the winners.
7. Scholarships shall be awarded to the winners during the Awards Ceremony.
8. If the scholarship is not used for the fall semester, it is forfeited. The award may be given to an alternate.
9. Awards will go to the seniors who have the greatest number of medal-points based on Gold=4, Silver=3, Bronze=2, 4th = 1.
