

SPECIAL PROGRAMS STUDENT ASSISTANT IN CAMPUS MINISTRIES

This assistant works with the Campus Minister to design and provide services and programming which supplement on-going activities of Campus Ministries and reach out to students not currently involved in campus spiritual life.

Responsibilities:

1. Work with the Campus Minister and student groups to plan and implement one-time events and new programs.
2. Work in cooperation with other spiritual life groups on campus.
3. Work with at least one other CMT member in following through on a “special project” that stems from your passion and interest.
4. Meet regularly with the Campus Minister for supervision.
5. Meet regularly with the Campus Ministry Team. Once the team has been chosen, members will select additional areas of leadership including: Taize services, Conversation Cafes, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Sing the Journey Nights, Shack City, local congregational connections, etc. CMT members may also work together on projects.
6. Attend Student Leaders' retreat at the beginning of Fall semester.
7. Engage in a regular “spiritual friendship” & local congregation.
8. Write a report summarizing your work at the end of the school year.

Qualifications:

1. Spiritual maturity and commitment.
2. Experience in leadership.
3. At least one year's attendance at GC.
4. Regular attendance at a local congregation.
5. GPA of 2.5 or more.
6. Not RA, Senate Executive, or CAC leader.

Time allotment:

An average of 3 hours per week
