

**CAMPUS WORSHIP NIGHT
STUDENT ASSISTANT IN CAMPUS MINISTRIES**

This assistant is responsible for the overall planning of Campus Worship Night, a weekly worship service for students, and brings together teams who lead music in a variety of styles for CWN, Chapel, and other events.

Responsibilities:

1. Give direction to planning, publicizing, and leading CWN.
2. Plan a worship service that provides opportunity for student involvement in praise and prayer.
3. Work co-operatively with other religious groups on campus.
4. Coordinate student teams who lead music for campus worship night, chapel, and other on-campus worship settings, as well as lead one of the teams.
5. Work effectively with student musicians to seek learning opportunities and to maximize the use of their gifts and talents for worship settings.
6. Meet regularly with the Campus Minister for supervision.
7. Meet regularly with the Campus Ministry Team. Once the team has been chosen, members will select additional areas of leadership including: Taize services, Conversation Cafes, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Sing the Journey Nights, Shack City, local congregational connections, etc. CMT members may also work together on projects.
8. Attend Student Leaders' retreat at the beginning of Fall semester.
9. Engage in a regular "spiritual friendship" & local congregation.
10. Write a year-end report summarizing your work.

Qualifications:

1. Spiritual maturity and commitment.
2. Ability to effectively involve other students in worship planning/leading.
3. Previous experience in leading a worship team.
4. Skills in music, organization and leadership.
5. At least one year's attendance at GC.
6. Regular attendance in a local congregation.
7. GPA of 2.5 or more.
8. Not RA, Senate Executive, or CAC leader.

Time allotment:

An average of 3 hours per week.

Remuneration:

Minimum wage.
