

INFORMATION SHEET

The Gorsline Excellence Award in Radio/TV/Film recognizes incoming students for creative production or journalistic achievement. Entries will be accepted for documentary, fictional or creative production works. All entries must be of work that has been produced in conjunction with a class, extra-curricular or church-related project.

The winner will receive an award certificate and a Gorsline Excellence Award of **\$1,000 to \$3,000 annually**. To be eligible for the scholarship, the winner must attend Goshen College and declare a major in Communication. The scholarship is renewable for a total of four years.

No more than one entry per contestant is permitted. Included with the entry should be a brief written description of the work submitted. TV and film works should be submitted on VHS or DVD. Radio works may be submitted on audiocassette, minidisc, or compact disc. Creative/artistic entries may be submitted on any of the above-mentioned media.

Entrants must also complete the general application form for the Gorsline academic scholarship and an entry form for the radio/TV/film contest. **Entries must be postmarked by the February 1, 2008, priority deadline.** Judging will be conducted by a panel consisting of members of the department and professional journalists. Winners will be announced in March.

The competition is being held in conjunction with Goshen College's Celebrate Scholar Day on Saturday, February 9. On this day, interviews will be held with entrants. We hope that all entrants can attend Celebrate Scholar Day. If distance or schedule makes this impossible, other arrangements will be made.
