## COMMUNICATION Application

You have indicated your interest in pursuing communication as a college major. In recognition of her commitment to communication, Kay Bandelier Gorsline established the Kay Bandelier Gorsline Scholarship for students majoring in this field at Goshen College. **The Gorsline Scholarship is from \$1,000 to \$2,000 annually.** Goshen College also recognizes excellence in print journalism and radio/TV/film production with an opportunity to receive a **Gorsline Excellence Award of \$1,000 to \$3,000 annually.** Details of this award are enclosed. Students interested should apply for the Kay Bandelier Gorsline Scholarship and indicate interest in the Excellence Award on the enclosed form.

### Eligibility

- The Gorsline Scholarship is available to students intending to major in communication. Gorsline recipients must be eligible for admission to Goshen College and have a cumulative high school grade point average of **3.0 or higher.**
- Transfers also must have a cumulative college GPA of **3.0 or higher.**
- *In addition to the Gorsline Communication Scholarship, a student is eligible for one more award from the following list: Academic Scholarship, Anglemyer Education, Athletic, Gorsline Business/Theater, Music Department Achievement Award, Swallen Missionary, and Tuition Discount Benefits. Goshen College limits merit awards so that more funds can be awarded on the basis of financial need. Students may apply for multiple scholarships and will be asked to choose two if awarded three or more.*

### Procedure for applying

- Complete the admission application for Goshen College by **December 15, 2008.**
- Complete the Gorsline Scholarship application.
- Respond to the short essay on the bottom of this application. The essay is to be no more than two typewritten, double-spaced pages.
- Interview at Goshen College on Saturday, January 24, 2009 at Celebrate Scholar Day. Students who cannot attend this event will be scheduled for phone interviews.
- Indicate on the enclosed form your interest in applying for the Gorsline Excellence Award.

### Renewal of award

Students may renew the scholarship for an additional six semesters after the first year by continuing to major in communication at Goshen College, by maintaining a grade point average of at least 3.0 and by participating in activities and programs of the department.
