

ANGLEMYER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

In recognition of their love for teaching, Harold and Elizabeth Anglemyer established the Anglemyer Education Fund for students from Elkhart and surrounding counties in Indiana who are planning careers in teacher education. In accordance with the Anglemyers' will, the fund provides a scholarship worth **\$1,000 to \$3,000 per year**, depending on financial need.

ELIGIBILITY:

The Anglemyer Education Fund is available to students at Goshen College intending to major in teacher education. Priority selection will go to students from Elkhart County; the next priority will be students from selected Indiana counties with any remaining funding to be awarded to students from Indiana.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- Complete the admission application for Goshen College by Dec. 15, 2011.
- Complete this Anglemyer Education Fund application.
- Respond to the items on the bottom of this application, using no more than two, double-spaced pages.
- Interview with GC teacher education personnel on Saturday, Jan. 21, 2011, at Celebrate Scholar Day.
- The interview is designed to explore your interest in and motivation for becoming a teacher. (Students who cannot attend this event will be scheduled for phone interviews.)

RENEWAL OF AWARD:

Availability of the award for a student's first two years is dependent on intent to enroll in the teacher education program and completion of this application,

short answer questions and an interview with teacher education personnel. Formal acceptance into the teacher education program at Goshen College typically occurs during the sophomore year and is dependent on college course work, scores on Praxis I examinations and recommendations from field placement supervisors. Availability of Anglemyer Education Fund proceeds for a student's junior and senior years is based on acceptance into the GC teacher education program. Students receiving Anglemyer Award funds based on financial need must complete the FAFSA by March 1 each year.

DEADLINES:

Applicants should complete all steps, except the interview with teacher education personnel, by the Dec. 15 priority deadline. Recipients of the Anglemyer Education Fund will receive at least \$1,000. To be eligible for up to an additional \$2,000 of need-based aid, applicants must also complete the FAFSA by March 1, 2012. If funds remain, Anglemyer awards will also be available to qualified students who complete the application process after Dec. 15.

- Priority application deadline: **Dec. 15, 2011**
- Interview date: **Jan. 21, 2012**
- Funds remaining after Jan. 21 will be distributed as applications are received.
