KAY BANDELIER GORSLINE SCHOLARSHIP FOR COMMUNICATION

You have indicated your interest in pursuing broadcasting, communication, journalism or public relations as a college major. In recognition of her commitment to communication, Kay Bandelier Gorsline established the Kay Bandelier Gorsline Scholarship for students majoring in these fields at Goshen College. The Gorsline Scholarship is from **\$1,000 to \$3,000 annually.**

ELIGIBILITY:

- The Gorsline Scholarship is available to students intending to major in broadcasting, communication, journalism or public relations.
- Gorsline recipients must be eligible for admission to Goshen College and have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
- Transfers must have a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- In addition to the Gorsline Communication Scholarship, a student is eligible for one more award from the following list: Academic Scholarship, Anglemyer Education, Athletic, Gorsline Business/Theater, Music Department Achievement Award, Swallen Missionary, and Tuition Discount Benefits. Students may apply for multiple scholarships and will be asked to choose two if awarded three or more.

RENEWAL OF AWARD:

- Students may renew the scholarship for an additional six semesters after the first year by continuing to major in broadcasting, communication, journalism or public relations, by maintaining a grade point average of at least 3.0 and by participating in activities and programs of the department.

PROCEDURE FOR APPLYING:

- Complete the admission application for Goshen College by Dec. 15, 2011.
- Complete this Gorsline Scholarship application.
- Respond to the essay prompt, using no more than two double-spaced pages.
- Students are encouraged to submit a sample of their portfolio, whether an article, audio file, photograph, video or other work.
- Interview at Goshen College on Saturday, Jan. 21, 2012, at Celebrate Scholar Day. Students who cannot attend this event will be scheduled for phone interviews.

DEADLINES:

- Priority application deadline: **Dec. 15, 2011**
- Interview date: **Jan. 21, 2012**
- Funds remaining after Jan. 21 will be distributed as applications are received.
