Discussion and lecture will focus on some basic key issues we all face in an educational setting. The presenter, along with participants, will offer some possible solutions within the educational setting. The group environment allows participants an opportunity to offer suggestions and receive feedback from individuals with various points of view. Topics covered will include: Best practices with regards to the Code of Professional Conduct, Conflicts with Staff or Teachers, Deciding When and What to Interpret, Interpreter Qualifications, and Cross-Cultural/Linguistic Mediation.

The Presenter: Josh Garrett, CI, CT, NIC, has been interpreting professionally since 1998. Josh is a faculty member at Goshen College within the Interpreter Training Program. He has taught for Purdue University in the Continuing Education Department Interpreter Certificate Program and serves as the Interpreter Coordinator and Mentor for a Deaf Ministry.
