Professional Development Session: This workshop will provide educational interpreters a safe and informative environment for learning and discussion. Discussion and lecture will focus on some basic key issues we all face in an educational setting. Topics covered will include: Interpreters' Role and Responsibilities, Professional Development, Effective Use of "Down Time", Substitute Interpreters, Visual Noise, Low Light or No Light Situations, Note-taking, Oral Testing, and Repetitive Strain Injury. The presenter, along with participants, will offer /discuss some possible solutions within the educational setting.

The Presenter: Josh Garrett, CI, CT, NIC, has been interpreting professionally since 1998. Josh is a faculty member at Goshen College within the Interpreter Training Program.
