

On the Road Program Fees

- On the Road programs are primarily available January 2 through the second week in February.
- These programs are designed for groups no larger than 30 students at one time.
- Programs can last one hour (or a class period if it's shorter than an hour) or 1 1/2 hours.
- Programs can be presented more than once a day at a site. There is a reduced fee for any programs after the first one. This works especially well for schools that have more than one class per grade level.
- Program sites can include inside a school building, outside on the school property, outside at a nearby natural area, outside at a park, etc. (Teachers would need to obtain permission from property owners for any site other than school property.)
- Many of the On the Road programs can work well as an introduction to a topic before coming to Merry Lea for a field trip!
- Program fees are based on the length of the program and the distance to travel from Merry Lea to the program site.

Program Length	Distance from Merry Lea (in miles)					Additional Program
	1-15	16-30	31-45	46-60	60+	
1 hour (or class period less than an hour)	\$80	\$110	\$140	\$170	\$170+ \$0.33 per mile	\$45

A pricing example:

A school 14 miles from Merry Lea schedules a 1 hour program for a class of 28 students. The cost of \$80 is equal to \$2.86/student. If Merry Lea presents the same program to a second class of 30 students on the same day, the total cost of \$125 is equal to \$2.16/student.
