Frequently Asked Questions:

What is this event?

The Seed Swap is an educational event for gardeners in the Michiana region to exchange or acquire seeds, learn about seed saving techniques and gardening practices and to network with other gardeners.

How does it work?

This is a buy/sell/trade event. Seeds will be available through sales, swaps, and for FREE thanks to generous donations. Participants are NOT required to bring seeds to the event, but if you save seed, please bring them along!

The swap will include:

- A Community Seed Table with free seeds (provided through generous donations)
- Resource tables highlighting regional businesses, organizations, and individuals involved in gardening, seed saving, and more.
- Educational sessions on a variety of topics

Who is the event for?

Everyone, from first-time gardeners or experienced growers. Participants will include home gardeners, community gardener organizers, small-scale growers, and those interested in local food systems. Children and families are welcome, as well as anyone interested in gardening and seeds!
