

Autumn Adventures PreK

Program Description

Discover how animals and plants prepare for winter by observing evidence and using all 5 senses in the forests, meadows and wetlands at Merry Lea. Students think like a woodchuck, scamper like a squirrel, compare seeds' characteristics and more to experience how Indiana's wildlife is adapted to survive winter.

Program Objectives

Students will:

- Use their senses to explore the world around them
- · Learn about life cycles and sequencing
- Discover what plants and animals are doing in the fall

Program Outline

1. Hike

Students head out on our trails to get a close-up view of what plants and animals are doing this time of year. They participate in age-appropriate scavenger hunts, games and other hands-on activities.
