- Admitted to Goshen College (note to visiting students: that process precedes your application to the SLS)
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Junior or Senior status during the program; sophomores who demonstrate exceptional preparedness will also be considered
- Willingness to actively participate in problem-based, collaborative learning
- Ability to participate in a wide variety of outdoor experiences and frequent regional travel
- Commitment to foster a positive learning experience within the group
- · Approval and recommendation of academic advisor, and one additional academic reference
- Recommendation of residential/student life and health/wellness offices at your home institution
