4) The student or spouse whose 2022 income from work must be reported on the FAFSA received unemployment compensation or nontaxable income in 2022 and had a complete loss for at least 10 weeks of those benefits.
5) The student has become separated or divorced after he or she submitted his or her application.
6) A spouse whose 2022 income from work must be reported on the FAFSA has died after the student has submitted his or her application.
7) The student's last surviving parent with whom the student had a dependency relationship, by virtue of not meeting the independent student criteria in section 411F(12)(A) of the HEA, has died after the student has submitted his or her application.
