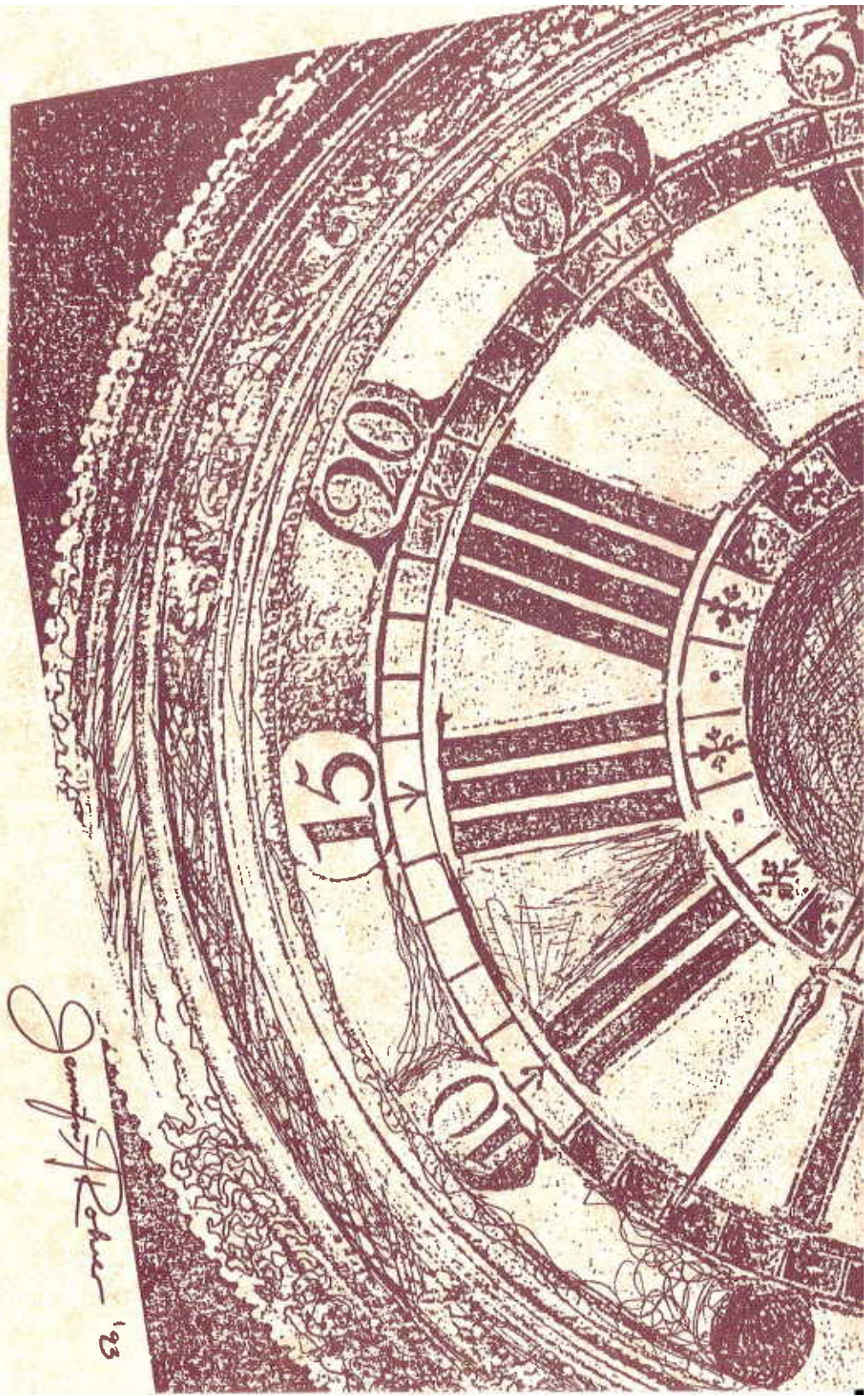
Chinese Exchange Program Scholars
