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Student Ministry Team Job Description – Campus Ministries

Student Ministry Team members seek to foster a welcoming spiritual atmosphere through cultivation of hospitality, dialogue, community-building, and care for the emotional and spiritual needs of peers.

SMT Faith Programming, Presence and Peer Support:

- Participate in the facilitation, leadership and promotion of events and programs with Campus Pastors and the Student Ministry Team
- Provide opportunities for students across campus to gather for Chapels, Worship, Study, Fellowship, Prayer and Faith Dialogue
- Collaborate with Residence Life to provide spiritual activities for various residence areas
- Help make students aware of local church options

SMT Spiritual Care and Training:

- SMTs meet together with Campus Pastors for regular meetings and leadership development
- SMTs meet 1-on-1 with a Campus Pastor throughout the semester for check-in, accountability and spiritual care
- SMTs are to have an active faith life and maintain regular spiritual practices to support it
- SMTs must attend a mandatory “SMT Orientation and Training” several days prior to the start of the school year

Qualifications for this position:

- Commitment to support the vision for faith development for all in Goshen college community
- Spiritual maturity and commitment to a faith tradition
- Active participation in community life
- Ability to work collaboratively as a member of the Student Ministry Team
- Willingness to develop leadership, listening and organizational skills
- Commitment to live out and uphold the Goshen College Community Standards
- At least one year’s attendance at Goshen College
- GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Ability to commit to position without conflict of interest from other leadership positions on campus

Benefits of taking on this leadership role:

- Stipend of \$500 for the year
- SMTs would move onto campus prior to the regular move-in days for orientation and training as SMTs and student leaders on campus.
- Key Student Learning Outcomes Engaged: Peacemaking, Identity, Christian Story, Communication, Critical and Reflective Thinking, Problem Solving, Faith in Action
